* Please flush any waste down the toilet before disposal.










Bowls




Broken fluorescent lamps

Place fluorescent lamps in the box from the new bulbs with which they are replaced




Wrap sharp objects e.g. knives, broken glass in newspaper, etc. and label it "KIKEN (dangerous)".



How to Put Out

In either a 'covered container' or 'see-through' bag.

↑ Items bear the plastic mark

How to Put Out


◆ Make sure the containers and packages are empty.




1. Rinse the inside with water or wipe with rags.
2. Place them in see-through bag.

Do not double bag.








(incl. books, notebooks, wrapping paper, postcard, cake box)




Cardboard



PET bottles

1. Remove the cap and the label.
2. Rinse the inside.
3. Flatten.
4. Place them in see-through bag.




Dispose of bottle caps and labels as Plastic mark

Bottles with PET mark are collected.


How to Put Out

◆ Bundle with string by item



Bottles


Bottles (bottles for Sake, Jam, Cosmetics (transparent), beverage)



Remove the caps and rinse the inside

Cans


Cans (cans for beverage, beer, food, snacks, and others)
* Steel and aluminum only



Spray cans/portable gas burner, gas cartridges
* Make sure that cans are empty and place them in see-through bag.


Metal pots/ pans/ kettles

* Items with dimensions of about 30cm or less (excluding the handle)




How to Put Out

Place bottles directly in yellow container



How to Put Out

Place them directly in blue container



Collection dates for Recyclable and Garbage

How to put out Garbage

- **Collection date:** No collection on Sundays.

Precautions

- Collection time of the **burnable** and **non-burnable** is divided into 3 periods, ① by 8 a.m. ② by 9:30 a.m. ③ by 0:30 p.m.
- Put out the **Plastic mark** items, **Recyclables**, **Large sized wastes** by 8:00 a.m.
- You are required to make an appointment to dispose large sized waste. Do not put out the large sized waste at the collection site on collection days.
- Always observe the rules when putting out your trash to avoid causing trouble for people nearby.
- Since there is a risk of animals, such as crows, scattering garbage, as well as a risk of making the collection site smell bad if you dispose of items on days other than the garbage collection day, please follow the collection schedule carefully.
- If you live in a large-scale communal housing complex, please be careful as the garbage/recyclable resource collection schedule may be different from the following list. For more information, please ask the superintendent of your building, the collection staff, or the Chuo Reuse Collection Office.

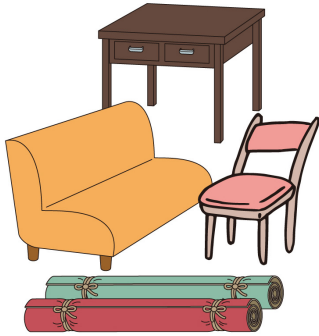

Furniture, or household goods with dimensions of about 30cm or more.

Large-sized Waste from business activities will not be collected.

Pre-paid large sized waste tickets

Buy a large sized disposal ticket from Chuo City at a convenience store or shops displaying the "Disposal Ticket for Large-sized Waste" in Chuo City.

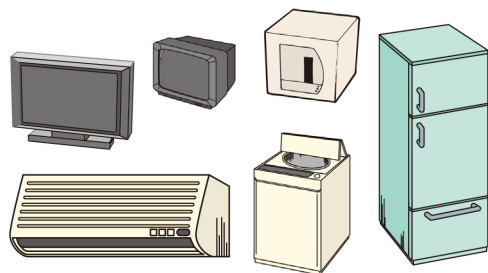
* Please consult with Chuo Refuse Collection Office if you have a difficulty to put out large sized waste because your household consists of only the disabled or the elderly aged 65 or older and you cannot get the help from your families and communities.



Items under the Home Appliance Recycling Law

* These items are not large sized wastes

Air conditioners, TVs, Refrigerators (Freezers), Washing machines, drying machines



Return to the retailer where you purchased the item or take to the retailer at which you will replace it. If the above is not possible due to moving, etc., contact the **Home Appliance Recycling Center**.

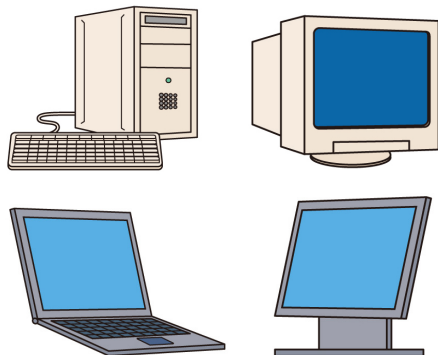

⚠ Computers which were disposed from the workplace will not be collected. Please contact authorized waste disposal dealers.



Personal computers that do not have PC Recycling mark on it, collection and recycling fees will be required.
